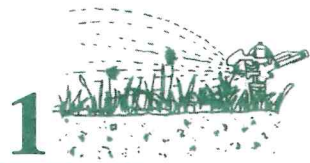


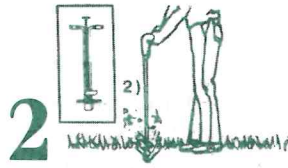
Plugging your lawn.

For installation in your present lawn or on a clean grade.



1 WATER AREA

Do not plant in dry ground. Water the area to be planted to make sure the soil is moist.



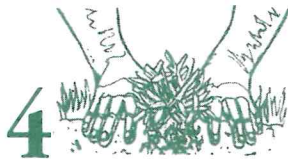
2 PREPARE HOLES

Make plug holes 12 to 24 inches apart in a checkerboard pattern. With a deposit, LUKAS NURSERY can provide you with a loaner plugger, for really fast plugging.



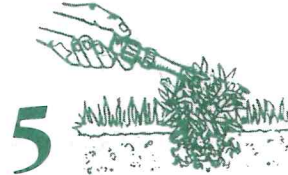
3 FERTILIZE

Apply 1/2 tsp. of Fertilome "Start N Grow" to each hole for rapid plug spreading.



4 INSTALLATION

Plant the plugs firmly. Be sure no air pockets are left around the plugs. The plugs runners should be perfectly flush to the ground—not too high and not buried.



5 WATER IN

Water in the plugs to completely eliminate air pockets around each plug.



6 WATER REGULARLY

Thoroughly water the completed lawn surface. Repeat sprinkling at regular intervals to keep plugs moist at all times until rooted. The first three weeks after installation are critical. After plugs are established, decrease frequency and increase amount of water per application.



7 IMPORTANT!

For best results, plugs should be fertilized with lawn food every 6-8 weeks until coverage occurs. Once established, follow the suggested care tips as outlined in the brochure available from LUKAS NURSERY.

Mowing plugs once they are firmly rooted in the ground promotes rapid spreading.



8 CARE & MAINTENANCE

After firm rooting occurs, the new plugs will begin to send our runners and create a beautiful new lawn. Provide at least 1" of water twice a week, and more during the dry months. Use a mower height of 1 1/2", slightly higher in shaded areas.

Turf Plugs

Floratam

Floratam is a vigorous growing variety of St. Augustine with good color, an upright growth pattern and coarse texture. Floratam is resistant to both chinch bugs and St. Augustine Decline. Floratam best performs in sunny areas. Mowing height 2 1/2" to 3".

Seville

Seville is a patented, lush, semi-dwarf St. Augustine grass with a dark green color and a dense compact growing pattern. It has good cold and shade tolerance and is also St. Augustine Decline resistant. Seville is the most beautiful and distinguishable of all present St. Augustine grasses. Mowing height 1 1/2" to 2".

Palmetto

This lush variety of St. Augustine prefers full sun but also offers superior shade tolerance. Due to its deeper root system, Palmetto exhibits better drought tolerance and resistance to cold and frost compared to that of other St. Augustine varieties. Mowing height 1 1/2" - 2 1/2".

"Empire" Zoysia

A new dwarf, soft, fine-bladed, barefoot grass that spreads from underground runners. Developed in Brazil, "Empire" Zoysia thrives in harsh tropical climates. With its soft to the touch feel, exceptional drought tolerance and reduced chemical, maintenance and mowing needs, it is the grass of the future for Central Florida. Mowing height 1" - 2".

Plugs can be placed at any desirable distance according to your own particular demands or budget.

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
