Plugging your lawn.

For installation in your present lawn or on a clean grade.



WATER AREA

Do not plant in dry ground. Water the area to be planted to make sure the soil is moist.



INSTALLATION

Plant the plugs firmly. Be sure no air pockets are left around the plugs. The plugs runners should be perfectly flush to the ground-not too high and not buried.



IMPORTANT!

For best results, plugs should be topped with "Fertilome New Lawn Starter Fertilizer" for vigorous growth and a strong root system. Mowing plugs once they are firmly rooted in the ground promotes rapid spreading.



PREPARE HOLES

Make plug holes 12 to 18 inches apart in a checkerboard pattern. With deposit, LUKAS NURSERY can provide you with a loaner plugger, for really fast plugging.



WATER IN

Water in the plugs to completely eliminate air pockets around each plug.



CARE & MAINTENANCE

After firm rooting occurs, the new plugs will begin to send out runners and create a beautiful new lawn. Provide at least 1" of water twice a week, and more during the dry months. Use a mower height of 11/2", slightly higher in shaded areas. Once established, follow the suggested care tips as outlined in the brochure available from LUKAS NURSERY.



FERTILIZE

Apply 1/2 tsp. of Fertilome "Start N Grow" and 1 tablespoon of Sunniland Pre-Plant to each hole for rapid plug spreading.



WATER REGULARLY

Thoroughly water the completed lawn surface. Repeat sprinkling at regular intervals to keep plugs moist at all times until rooted. The first three weeks after installation are critical. After plugs are established, reduce watering frequency.



Grass Plugs

FloratamTM

Floratam is a vigorous growing variety of St. Augustine with good color, an upright growth pattern and coarse texture. Floratam performs best in **sunny areas**. Mowing height 3" to 4".

Seville

Seville is a lush, semi-dwarf St. Augustine grass with a dark green color and a dense compact growing pattern. It thrives in full sun to partial shade. Seville is beautiful and requires less mowing than other varieties of St. Augustine grasses. Mowing height 2" to 3".

Palmetto®

This variety of St. Augustine **prefers full sun but also offers superior shade tolerance.** Due to its deeper root system, Palmetto exhibits better drought tolerance and resistance to cold and frost compared to that of other St. Augustine varieties. Mowing height 3" - 4".

ProVista®

This new, revolutionary variety of St. Augustine, derived from the long-standing genetics of Floratam and developed by Scotts [®], offers a deep green color in **full sun to moderate shade**. Its dense, slow growing, horizontal growth habit and weed-free capability can cut your mowing time down significantly. Mowing height 2" to 3".

Zoysia

A dwarf, soft, fine-bladed, barefoot grass that spreads from underground runners. Found in Brazil and Australia, Zoysia thrives in harsh tropical climates. With its soft to the touch feel, exceptional drought tolerance and reduced chemical, maintenance and mowing needs, it is the grass of the future for Central Florida. Mowing height 1" - 2".

How Many Do I Need?

Plugs can be placed at any desirable distance according to your own particular demands or budget. Generally, an even spacing of 12" - 18" on center will provide good coverage. 18 grass plugs will provide coverage for approx. 40 sq. ft.
